

Using The iPad The PRIDEFUL Way

1. Use the iPad for educational use - I use the iPad the same way at BOTH school and home = TO CONTINUE LEARNING



2. Bring my iPad to school EVERY day CHARGED and READY TO GO



3. Be respectful, responsible, and safe with the iPad = PRIDEFUL CHOICES



4. Take care of the iPad so that it works at school and home



5. Keep the iPad in the protective carrying case

6. Make sure the iPad is not in places of hot temperatures and away from food or drinks



7. Keep the iPad looking the same when IT was given to me - no stickers on it



8. Use the right cord carefully when charging and unplugging the iPad



9. Use a clean, soft cloth to clean the iPad and screen - no chemical cleansers



10. Putting apps and downloading software, songs, photos, or videos is not allowed



11. The iPad belongs to the school and District 66 - I am just borrowing it like a library book



12. If the iPad gets broken or lost, then the parents/guardians may be responsible for fixing or replacing it



13. If the iPad doesn't work or has a problem, then I and/or parents/guardians must tell the teacher as soon as possible - within the next day
